




Tree Selection and Planting

What to look for in nursery stock

- Vigorous Plant
- Healthy Foliage
- Branch Spacing
- Trunk Taper



- Solid Root Ball Healthy roots
- Abundant Non-circling Roots



Stem girdling roots






Dig your planting hole – Set the tree
